



SERVICE DESCRIPTION: RECIPE FOR RENOVATION

The Recipe for Renovation is a limited design service, tailored give you a detailed and dimensioned vision of your personalized kitchen space. The goal of the service is to provide the foundation for a coherent, creative design, placing the value of our involvement at the conceptual and planning phases of a project.

Our approach is to provide a 'recipe' for the design that you can implement with a contractor or design/build team. We believe that the best results come after a little experimentation on the part of the chef, so your hands-on involvement is factored into the process.

STEP ONE: As-built documentation and site visit

Cindy will coordinate a time to meet at your house to review existing conditions, take several measurements of the kitchen, and discuss your goals for functionality and design. She'll take note of your cooking rituals and any specific storage needs to accommodate equipment.

STEP TWO: Plan sketches

We'll meet at our office to present several sketches of kitchen layouts for you to consider. Based on your feedback, we'll move forward with the plan that best suits you and your house.

STEP THREE: Design and Creative Vision

With the plan in place, we'll begin to develop the ideas for the kitchen design. The first major selection to make is the appliance package. Cindy will email several suggestions, along with references to showrooms in your area. This process will continue for countertops, fixtures, hardware and finishes.

STEP FOUR: We'll meet at our office or a local showroom to share our resources and introduce you to the professionals that can help you finalize your selections. At this time, we will present our final design documents:

- A1: as-built plan and project inspiration images
 - A2: plan layout of new kitchen, mapped out with storage, appliances, electrical and plumbing fixtures
 - A3: finish selection guide based on the design concept
 - A4: 3d renderings of the kitchen spatial concept
